 - b. A teacher

The references should write a paragraph on your character, why they would recommend you for such a scholarship.

D. All applicants will write a brief essay explaining "Why they feel community, helping others and leadership are important on and off the court!" *Submission requires a minimum of 200 words, with a max of 500.*
